Augmentation Grant

- The Budget Act of 2018 (SB840) and trailer bill (SB843) allocated \$35M in one-time funds
- Three-Year Spending Period (July 2018 June 2021)
 - One-Year College/District Spending Period (July 2019 June 2020)
- Funding to support existing California Community Colleges in accelerating innovative online learning opportunities leading to increased employ-ability and upward mobility for working Californians.

Augmentation Grant Goals

Award grants to help colleges and/or districts complete shortterm projects that align with one or both of the two goals described in the budget language.

 Develop online programs and courses that lead to to shortterm, industry-valued credentials

or

Enable a student in a pathway developed by the California
 Online Community College to continue his or her education in
 a career pathway offered by an existing community college.

Augmentation Grant Focus Areas

- Three primary focus areas (or tracks):
 - Improve access to quality online CTE-oriented programs or credentials
 - 2. Filling gaps in online or potentially online programs that meet workforce demands
 - 3. Enhancing support structures for students, faculty and colleges in taking/delivering these programs
- Project Name: Improving Online CTE Pathways

Two-Phased Grant Approach

Phase One: Grant Planning & Development

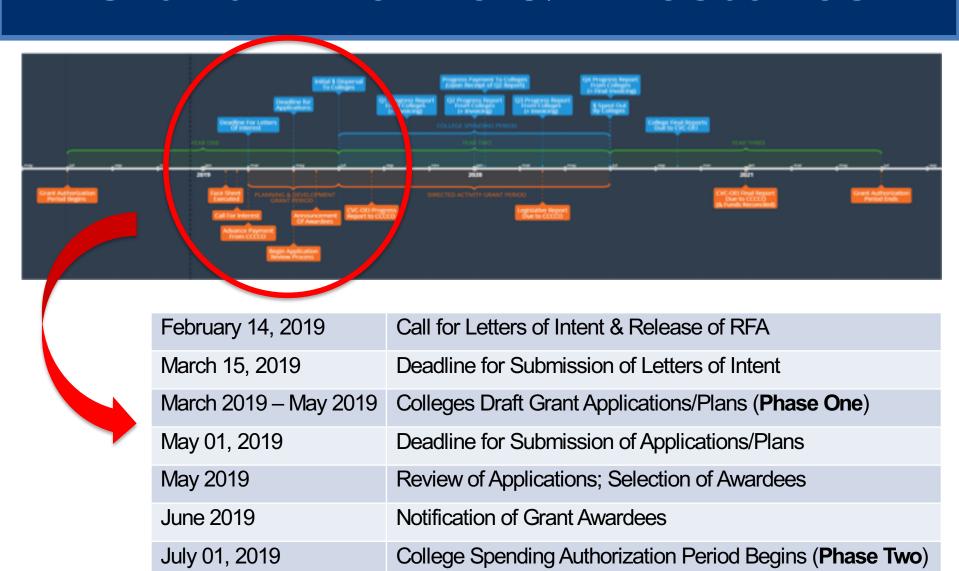
- College and/or districts form local planning teams
- Includes up to \$15,000 cost reimbursement
- Planning Period: Feb 14, 2019 May 01, 2019

(May commence upon acceptance of Letter of Interest, due no later than Mar 15)

Phase Two: Grant Implementation

- Grant Awards (based on local college plans submitted)
- Awards up to \$500,000 (depending on quantity / quality)
- Review & Notification Period: May 01, 2019 May 31, 2019
- Awardee Authorization Period: Jul 01, 2019 Jun 30, 2020

Background

With an open access mission, the California Community Colleges are positioned to support our diverse population to increase wages and improve social mobility in a rapidly changing economy. In addition to the formation of a new online community college, the California legislature and governor have provided funding to support existing California Community Colleges in accelerating innovative online learning opportunities leading to increased employ-ability and upward mobility for working Californians.

The Budget Act of 2018 (SB840) and trailer bill (SB843) appropriate one-time funds of \$35 million to the Online Education Initiative (through Foothill – De Anza Community College District as grantee and fiscal agent) to develop online programs and courses that do either of the following:
